WHAT HAPPENS AT AWANA CLUB

A typical Sparks and T&T Club meeting looks like this (Cubbies have special schedule):

Opening: Clubbers open with the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag, the AWANA Pledge, the Awana Song, announcements and prayer.

Handbook Time: During Awana club each child is given the opportunity to memorize and recite Bible verses, Biblical concepts and activities from their individual Handbook.

Council Time: Here the clubbers listen to a Bible lesson led by a Bible teacher.

Game Time: The clubbers enjoy a time of safe, fun-filled games.
