- 3. To stand at the ready

B. SOME REASONS FOR DEVOTION - See Matthew 6:9-13

- 1. Prayerful worship (9)
- 2. Prayerful submission (10)
- 3. Prayerful request (11)
- 4. Prayerful repentance (12)
- 5. Prayerful protection (13)

C. SOME EXAMPLES OF PERSISTENT PRAYER

D. DEVOTED PRAYER DROPOUTS

- 1. Some will quit due to disbelief > It doesn't work!
- 2. Others stop due to disappointment > I didn't get what I wanted!
- 3. People quit because of impatience > I'm tired of waiting on the Lord

II. BE ALERT IN PRAYER

A. BE WATCHFUL

- 1. Knowing what's going on around you and praying accordingly
- 2. Being diligently devoted to the work of prayer

B. BE AWARE ...

- 1. Of you needs
- a. There's a weak flesh within you Mark 14:38
- b. There's a devouring devil around you I Peter 5:7
- 2. Of other's needs
- a. The saints need prayer support See Eph. 6:18
- b. They will need you to assist them

C. BE FOCUSED - I Peter 4:7

- 1. Being sensible and self-controlled so as to pray at any time
- 2. Being specific in prayer

D. BE ADVISED: Some practical suggestions for alert praying

- 1. Pray Scripture
- 2. Pray by singing worship songs and hymns
- 3. Pray in a place without distractions
- 4. Pray standing up
- 5. Pray out loud
- 6. Pray on an empty stomach
- 7. Pray after proper rest
