Philippians 1:27-28

1. Being an honorable citizen in God’s community is part of what’s involved in worthy conduct.
 - What are some things that you notice in people you do not know or do not know well, that makes you think that they are believers?
 - What actions do you seek to demonstrate in your everyday life that would reveal to others your Christianity?
2. Hypocrisy is acting in a way contrary to what one says that they are.
 - What kinds of hypocrisy on the part of other professed believers especially bothers you?
 - We should pray that we will be genuine, unhypocritical followers of Jesus
3. We know that people talk about us.
 - What are some good things that you can say about others in your group tonight?
4. As “worthy conduct” believers we must stand firm in our resolve to live out a committed Christianity.
 - What are some of the cultural clashes we face in doing so?
 - In what ways do you struggle with this the most?
5. Striving together for the gospel is important.
 - How do you seek to share your faith with others?
 - Do you have ideas about how FRBC could better evangelize our community?
6. Paul expected Christians to cooperate.
 - What are some good examples of cooperation that you’ve seen in our church or in other congregations?
7. We are called to be confident, fearless Christians, unafraid of our opponents.
 - What opposition do you fear the most?
 - How can you overcome that fear?
 - We should pray for those facing opposition and that God will give them courage and hope in withstanding it.
